WHEREAS, the theme of this year's competition, "Taking a Stand in History," asked students to examine moments in history where people used force, words, and economic power to make their voices heard;

WHEREAS, their project, entitled "Standing Up for Equal Education: How a Father's Courageous Fight Led to the Desegregation of California's Schools" was entered in the senior group exhibit category and was selected for a California Historic Places Award; and,
