PROJECT TITLE: Easement Realignment and Right of Entry Permit

LOCATION: Palomar Mountain State Park, State Park Road and Doane Valley Road
COUNTY: San Diego

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Grant a Right of Entry Permit and interest in real property via a new easement from DPR to SDG&E for the purposes of the installation and maintenance of an underground electrical line serving DPR’s maintenance shed at Palomar Mountain State Park. SDG&E will quitclaim their interest in the old easement alignment. Evaluation of the installation of the underground electrical service line was evaluated under CEQA in October 2008 and a Notice of Exemption was filed 10/17/08 (SCH# 2008108232). DPR-approved standard project requirements have been incorporated into this project. REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: No potential for significant impacts to the environment is anticipated in compliance with Section 15300.2. Project consists of minor alterations in land use limitations in areas with an average slope of less than 20%, which do not result in any changes in land use or density, and is included as “Issuance of easements and permits” and “issuance of rights-of-way” under DPR’s list of exempt activities In accordance with CCR § 15300.4.
